COURSE OUTLINE

To achieve Certificate II in Rural Operations students **must** achieve competence in the **2** Core Competencies plus complete **13** Elective Competencies from those listed below. This qualification provides an occupational outcome for industries and agencies in rural and regional Australia. Further training pathways from this qualification include Certificate III in Agriculture and many others. It suits multifunctional job roles for regional areas in particular.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed on their practical skills in the workplace and simulated workplace as well as associated theory units. All assessment will be competency based which means students are assessed as to whether they can consistently do the task competently, safely and efficiently to a predetermined standard. If students complete all the necessary Industry Training Units of Competency they will be awarded a Certificate II in Rural Operations. A Statement of Attainment will be issued if a full certificate is not completed.
