AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Certificate III in Agriculture proves a general vocational outcome in Agriculture. The qualification enables individuals to select competencies for a farming focus in crop production and agribusiness. This qualification leads to further pathways in agriculture eg: Certificate IV and Diploma of Agriculture.

COURSE OUTLINE

To achieve Certificate III in Agriculture, students must achieve competence in the 2 Core Competencies plus 14 Elective Competencies, from those listed below.

QCE Credits on successful completion – 8.

ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed on their practical skills in the workplace and simulated workplace as well as associated theory units. All assessment will be competency based which means students are assessed as to whether they can consistently do the task competently, safely and efficiently to a predetermined standard. If students complete all the necessary Industry Training Units of Competency they will be awarded a Certificate III in Agriculture. A Statement of Attainment will be issued if a full certificate is not completed.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS
